

QUALIFYING OPENS FOR JEFFERSON COUNTY OFFICES

Qualifying is open through 5 p.m. April 4 for the June 3 Democratic primary. Candidates must file their qualifying documents and fee by the deadline in order to be on the ballot. These are the county positions and their qualifying fees:
